

**For Teachers:** Enter your username and password on the Login page.

Click on [Create accounts for pupils](#)

Enter your pupils' names and create individual passwords. Your pupils' usernames and passwords are saved on this page.

A record of results and progress is held for each pupil.

[View pupils' results](#) - teachers can view a summary table of the tests taken and results achieved by each pupil. Click on individual names to view more detailed results.

Go to Login page and enter [sampleclass@ts.com](mailto:sampleclass@ts.com) and [class1](#) to view sample teacher's account.

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### For Pupils:

A pupil can only access and view his/her tests and results. A pupil enters his/her username and password on the Login page and clicks on the [Vocabulary & Spelling Tests](#) section on the left-hand side. Five options are available:

- [My Results](#) – Pupil can view all his/her results.
- [Try Again Bucket](#) – This holds the words that a pupil has answered incorrectly and can retake. Pupil should try and empty the bucket every week.
- [Start New Test](#) – Pupil selects one of the 6 Levels and the first 5 tests come up on the account for the pupil to complete. 10 questions can be attempted in each test
  - after entering answers, click on the submit button at the bottom of the page
  - answers are corrected and a score out of 10 is awarded
  - pupils earn Cherry Points when they achieve 100% in each test 🍒 🍒 🍒
  - words answered incorrectly are stored in the pupil's TRY AGAIN BUCKET
  - pupils can earn cherry points when they empty the TRY AGAIN BUCKET
  - when 10 cherry points are earned then the **Bronze** Cherry is awarded to the pupil and the bronze icon is activated. Pupils can go on to earn a **Silver** Cherry, and finally a **Gold** cherry, when all tests in the level have been completed successfully.
- [Access all tests & answers](#) – To learn new words pupils can select a level and test and read the information on each word to see if they know the answer. They can then click on the [Show the Answer](#) button to view the correct answer.
- [Making Progress Tests - Download](#) – We have created written tests with a selection of 10 words from the previous 5 lessons/tests. Pupils can print off these tests to A4 sheets and write in their answers. One point awarded for the correct word and a bonus point for the correct spelling of the word.

A **parent** will only be able to access and view his/her child's tests and results. Parents can help with [Access all tests & answers](#) section and view words on mobiles, tablets and PCs.

**CERTIFICATES** – Hardcopies of certificates can be printed off and presented to pupils. Click on [Teachers](#) at top of home page to download blank copies.

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**Tell & Spell at home - Remote online learning.**  
**Teacher/Parent and Pupil interaction.**

1. Working one-to-one with a pupil a teacher would use the [Access all tests & answers](#) section to go through each word in each test.

With remote online learning this can be done by a parent at home with the pupil or by the pupil himself.

The approach is for the pupil to listen to or read the information on each word and then click on [Show The Answer](#) button to view the correct answer. A child can visit this application/folder numerous times and revise and learn familiar and unfamiliar words and view words on mobiles, tablets and PCs.

2. A pupil can attempt to take the test in the [Start New Test](#) section.

3. When a test is taken, incorrect answers are recorded and the word sent to the pupil's [Try Again Bucket](#). A pupil should visit her bucket every week and attempt the words again and try and empty the bucket before moving on to the next test.

So there are 3 applications/folders for the pupil to log into and concentrate on one test per week :

[Try Again Bucket](#)

Learn the words Mon-Wed,

take the test on Thursday and

empty Try Again Bucket on Friday.

So one test over a one week period could be planned as:

Select Test to be covered for the week (let's say Level 2, test 6)

Pupil logs in with her username and password (created and supplied by teacher) and selects Vocabulary & Spelling Tests on left-hand side of her account.

Pupil selects one of the 3 applications/folders as outlined above depending on what stage she is at with the test.

When a teacher logs into her class account she can access all of the 3 applications/folders and see each pupils' activity and a record of their attempts and results.
